85 % Merlot - 10 % Cabernet Franc
5% Cabernet-Sauvignon

2.35 hectares

Average age of the vines : 45 years old

Soil of fine gravel (Libourne and Pomerol)
with traces of ferruginous sandstone in
the subsoil

Tillage of the soil and grass cover every
other row

46 HI/Ha

Fermentations in temperature-controlled
stainless steel vats

Aging in French oak barrels (1/3 new, 1/3
one year old)

Certified HVE 3 since the 2018 vintage



Deep colour, rich nose of black fruit with
hints of spices evolving into ripe fruit
aromas on the palate lifted by a both
elegant and powerful backbone.
